



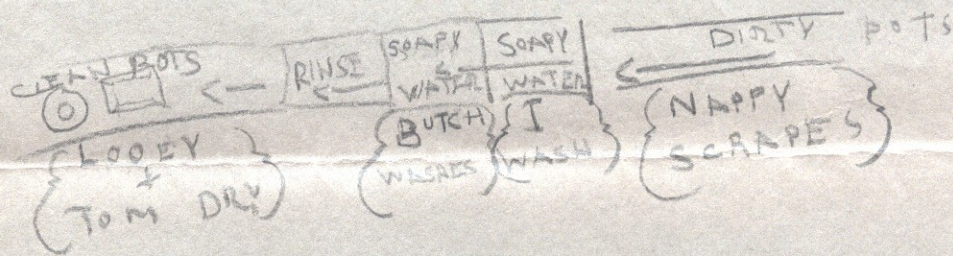
Sunday morning
